PUBLISH OPEN ACCESS WITH US

GOLD

- Submit your article/manuscript
- After peer review, contract and licence agreement, pay OA fees for books or Article Processing Charges for journals
- The final Version of Record of your article/ book is available OA

GREEN

- Submit your article/manuscript
- After peer review and contract you can deposit the Author Accepted version of the article/manuscript in an OA institutional repository
- For books an embargo may apply

FLEX

- We recognise a one-size fits all approach doesn't work for everyone, so for books we are happy to discuss flexible solutions
- We are also working on innovative new models for both books and journals
